Introduction

The purpose of the event is to provide the participants with a basic understanding of the international nuclear non-proliferation regime and the practical knowledge and skills required for safeguards implementation by States with comprehensive safeguards agreements.

Objectives

The course will provide participants with practical training in the establishment and maintenance of an effective state system of accounting for and control of nuclear material to satisfy both national and IAEA safeguards requirements.

Target Audience

The training course is open to 24 participants from IAEA Member States with nuclear facilities and a safeguards agreement in force. Preference will be given to candidates from developing countries but candidates may also be accepted from developed countries, provided that the cost of their participation is borne by the nominating Government.

English

Participation and Registration

All persons wishing to participate in the event have to be designated by an IAEA Member State or should be members of organizations that have been invited to attend.

Designations should be submitted to the IAEA via the InTouch+ platform (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org>) through the competent national authority (Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) not later than **05 October 2026**. If no access to InTouch+ is possible, the attached Participation Form (Form A) will be exceptionally accepted. Selected participants will be informed in due course on the procedures to be followed with regard to administrative and financial matters.

Participants are hereby informed that the personal data they submit will be processed in line with the [Agency's Personal Data and Privacy Policy](#) and is collected solely for the purposes of reviewing and assessing the application and to complete logistical arrangements where required. The IAEA may also use the contact details of Applicants to inform them of the IAEA's scientific and technical publications, or the latest employment opportunities and current open vacancies at the IAEA. These secondary purposes are consistent with the IAEA's mandate.

Expenditures and Grants

No registration fee is charged to participants. The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the Training Activities. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Such assistance may be offered upon specific request to normally one participant per country provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant on whose behalf assistance is requested will make an important contribution to the Training Activities. The application for financial support should be made at the time of designating the participant by indicating the need for financial support in Form A
