Subject: Regional Workshop on Flow Accelerated Corrosion and Dissimilar Metal Welds, Vienna, Austria, from 14 to 17 April 2025

Dear National Liaison Officer / National Coordinator,

I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER2019, “Enhancing Capacity for the Subsequent Operation of Nuclear Power Plants Beyond their Existing Long-Term Operation Programmes”.

The purpose of the workshop is to share information on Flow Accelerated Corrosion (FAC) and Dissimilar Metal Welds (DMW) in Nuclear Power Plants (NPPs). The discussion includes scientific basis and practical measures, operating experience feedback, managerial issues and regulatory aspects.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details, including technical and administrative aspects of the event. Selection of participants will be in accordance with IAEA procedures. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify women participants.

The IAEA will provide non-local participants with a round-trip air ticket based on the most direct and economical route between the airport nearest the participant’s residence and Vienna or a travel allowance to purchase an air ticket. Travel details will be agreed with the participants upon receipt of their official nomination. Participants will also receive an allowance from the IAEA sufficient to cover their costs of lodging, daily subsistence and miscellaneous expenses for the duration of the event in line with IAEA rules and procedures.
